Notification of overnight works on the A46 at Wanlip interchange (A6)

I am writing to let you know about essential resurfacing works on the A46 at its junction with the A6, Wanlip interchange. These works will commence 9th January 2019 for approximately 3 weeks.

To minimise inconvenience and disruption to the travelling public, we will carry out the work overnight from **8pm to 6am, Monday to Friday**. We will only work on weekends if absolutely necessary.

Upcoming closures

For safety we will need to close the road. The coming overnight closures are programmed as below:

- 9th to 10th January Westbound lane 1 closure. The slip road and Rectory Road approaching Wanlip will be closed. Lane 2 will remain open.
- 11th January Westbound **full closure**, from Hobby Horse to Wanlip (see attached plan for diversion route).
- 14th to 18th January Westbound lane 1 closure. The slip road and Rectory Road approaching Wanlip will be closed. Lane 2 will remain open.
- 21st January Eastbound lane 1 closure. The slip road approaching Wanlip will be closed. Lane 2 will remain open.
- 22nd January Eastbound **full closure** from Anstey to Wanlip. The Eastbound slip road at Groby (from the A50 to the A46) will also be closed. (see attached plan for diversion route).
- 23rd to 24th January Eastbound lane 1 closure. The slip road approaching Wanlip will be closed. Lane 2 will remain open.

Please note that all planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our

very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.

How will the work affect traffic?

Before a road is closed we will put in place fully signed diversion routes, which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

For the Rectory Road and slip road closures, short local diversion routes will be put in place (to the next A46 junction and back). Please see the attached plan for details of the diversion route during full closures.

The road will remain open to traffic between the hours of 6am and 8pm and throughout the weekend as usual.
